Student Donation Drive for Service Hours

How to do a Donation Drive for Service Hours:

- 1. Ask permission from your parents.
- 2. Print out the Donation Drive for Students Registration Form.
- 3. Print out the Donation Drive Hours Log to help you keep track of the tasks you perform.
- 4. Decide which items you would like to collect (see Hours Earned for Donated Items for a list of items needed).
- 5. Decide when, where, and from whom you will ask for donations.
- 6. Make fliers and posters advertising your donation collection.
- 7. Ask people to donate needed items advertise at school, church or temple, ask your friends, family, neighbors, local businesses, etc. Be sure to log all of your activity!
- 8. When your donation collection is over, please take a photo of you with all the items you collected and attach it to the form.
- 9. Fill out the Community Service Project Reflection Questions in this packet. Then ask a parent to email Rachel@jeffersonSPCA.org to arrange a time and date to drop off your donations. If you send scans of all the paperwork once complete via email as well, the letter of documentation can be prepared prior to drop off to make the process easier. Remember to bring your completed paperwork with you when you drop off donations.

** Please note: Drop Off will be at Jefferson Feed, 4421 Jefferson Hwy., Jefferson, LA 70121. The Jefferson SPCA is inside of Jefferson Feed.
